Horsham College offers a comprehensive educational program – it is a school which has pathways to suit all students.




- Highest performing government school above 500 outside of metro Melbourne 2 out of last 3 threes - top 5 last 5 years

Percentage of students in top two bands between 2016 and 2018






Top two levels Year 9 – NAPLAN Reading 2016–18 DET School Panoramic Report


Percentage of students in top two bands between 2016 and 2018






Top two levels Year 9 – NAPLAN Writing 2016–18 DET School Panoramic Report


