#### **Introduction**

The Horsham College Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program was introduced in 2016 to enable students to have their own digital device while giving flexibility of choice. In 2021 Horsham College began a large transition away from iPads to Notebooks, to enable a more varied approach to new skills. In 2023 Years 7,8 & 9 will be part of the Notebook Program. Students will require a Windows or Apple BYOD notebook device. If your iPad was purchased in 2021/22 it may still be used in year 7
