Introduction

The Horsham College Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program was introduced in 2016 to enable students to have their own digital device while giving flexibility of choice. In 2021 Horsham College began a large transition away from iPads to Notebooks, to enable a more varied approach to new skills. In 2027 all school years at Horsham College will be part of the Notebook Program. Students will ideally acquire a Windows notebook device less than two years old. Chromebooks, Apple MacBooks and Apple iPads can only be supported for basic functions and are no longer recommended.

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About BYOD

BYOD is a very commonly adopted system utilised by schools, universities and some workplaces to enable individuals to have a choice to choose the device they are most familiar and comfortable working with.

How does the BYOD Program work?

All students are required to bring their notebook charged ready for use each day, Horsham College recommend devices meet our minimum specifications.

How do I purchase a device?

3. Insurance

Accidents happen and that's why it's highly recommended that accidental damage cover is added with your purchase. This can be done through the supplier or your personal insurance.

Minimum Device Specifications

To maintain compatibility with school systems - Tablets, iPads and Chromebooks are not recommended. Apple devices can be supported but can experience compatibility issues with the school network.
